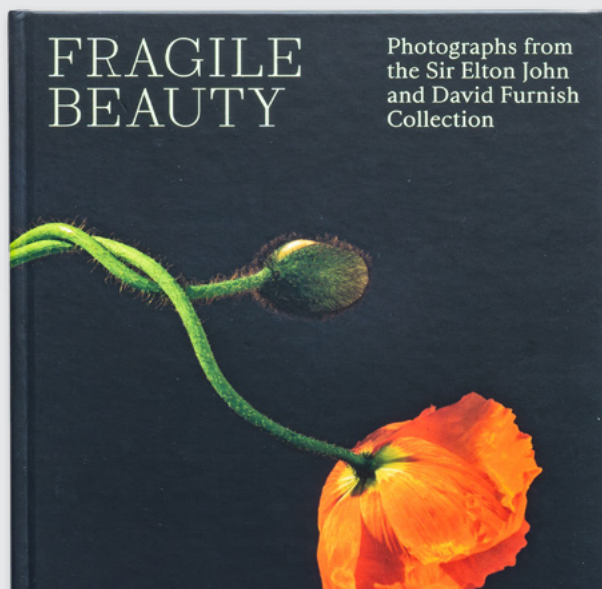
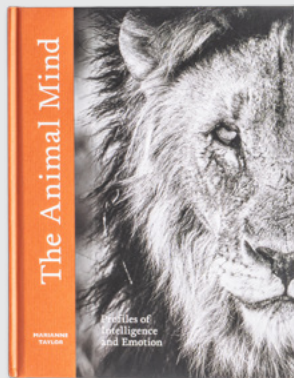
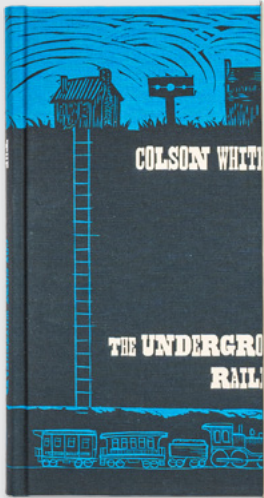

As one of the most prestigious and popular literary events of the year, the awards recognise and celebrate excellence in the British book design and production – honouring the best books of the year across a wide range of genres and formats from Best Jacket / Cover Design to Children’s Trade.

We’re thrilled to introduce two brand-new categories this year:

**Best in Book Finishing** – Honouring exceptional finishing techniques that enhance the overall design, feel and impact of a book.

**Excellence in Print Production** – Recognising innovation, sustainability and excellence across the entire print production process

With 18 inspiring categories and a panel of expert judges, now is the time to prepare your entries and be part of the industry’s most prestigious celebrations of book design and production.

Each finalist and winner of the 2025 British Book Design and Production Awards will receive:

### ENTRY GUIDELINES

All entries must be published, designed, typeset, printed or bound by the entrant in the UK. Exceptions apply for the Best British Book and Excellence in Print Production categories – books entered into these categories must be produced entirely in the UK.

You may enter a title into more than one category, but a separate copy of the book must be submitted for each category entered.

For the Self-Published Books and Excellence in Print Production categories, a written submission must also be provided along with the physical book of the book. Please email all written submissions to [heena.bulsara@bpif.org.uk](mailto:heena.bulsara@bpif.org.uk)

### JUDGING PROCESS

The judges will be looking for exceptional design, free of typographical errors, with particular emphasis given to excellent layout and standards of typography. The judges reserve the right to move books into another category if it seems appropriate.

### DEADLINES

All books published from **1 August 2024 until 7 November 2025** are eligible for entry in this year’s awards.

**The deadline for entries is Friday 28 November 2025**

Student entries: **Free of charge**

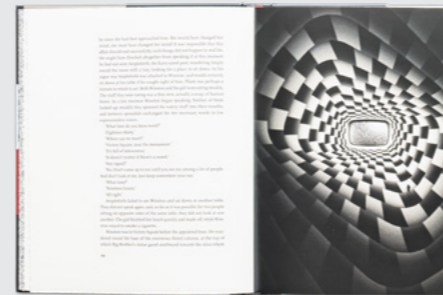
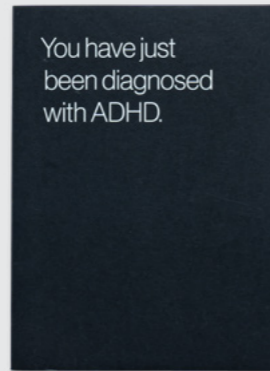
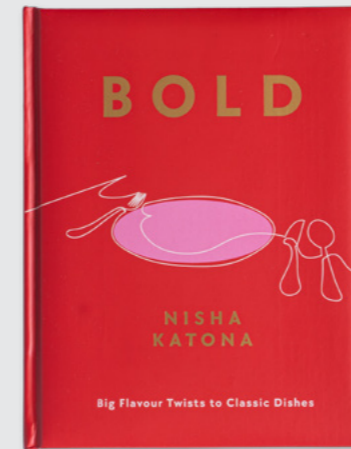

### 2024 BOOK OF THE YEAR

#### JUDGES’ COMMENTS

Nineteen Eighty-Four stood out from all the other fantastic entries this year. It was a stunning showcase of how to bring aesthetics to a classic piece of literature. The book conveys astounding finishing, beautifully bound and mesmerising illustrations that capture the feel of the book. This is a stunning combination of design and print production; with all aspects setting new heights, making this a very worthy overall winner.



## CATEGORIES

### BEST BRITISH BOOK

Exemplifying the highest standards of book design, production and printing, this category is open only to books that are published, printed and bound in the UK and should serve as a celebration of the British Print Industry.

### BEST STUDENT BOOK

This category is open to anyone currently enrolled in full – or part-time education on a recognised publishing, printing or design-based course within the UK and Ireland. There is no entry fee for this category.

Entries must include a signed letter from the student's course professor confirming the course title, college/university name and course dates.

The winner will receive £500 in prize money and the opportunity to gain work experience with a designer, publisher or printer.

### FINE BINDING

Entries in this category should be a binding of excellent standard of craftsmanship, alongside concept and design innovation. This category showcases the skills and fine detail applied to the book-binders art.

### BRAND / SERIES IDENTITY

A minimum of four books needs to be submitted for this category with at least one book published in the relevant year. Each book should reflect and promote the series whilst extending the value of the 'collection.'

### SELF-PUBLISHED BOOKS

This category celebrates and recognises authors who have worked tirelessly to bring their own stories to life - sourcing their own means and resources to design, print and publish their books independently.

Entries are welcome across all subject areas, but must be accompanied by a written submission of up to 500 words, outlining how you self-promoted your book – for example:

- How you marketed or advertised the book
- Where and how it's being sold
- Any events, online promotion or media coverage
- How you reached your readers

### BEST IN BOOK FINISHING

This category recognises outstanding finishing work that enhances the overall design, feel and impact of a book. The finish must add to the design of the book, making it more effective as an overall piece and exhibiting great finishing choices and techniques.

To be eligible, entries must feature one or more finishing techniques, such as:

- Cloth, (faux) leather or textured materials
- Metallic foil blocking, embossing or debossing
- Laminates (e.g gloss, matte, soft-touch)
- Or other creative finishing methods

### EXHIBITION CATALOGUES

These need to have been produced to the highest standards of print quality, with fully documented entries and illustrations.

### PHOTOGRAPHIC BOOKS

These need to have been produced to the highest standards of print quality photos.

### ART / ARCHITECTURE MONOGRAPHS

This category is suitable for the highest quality of image reproduction that should create something visually stunning for the high-end market.

### TRADE ILLUSTRATED

General non-fiction featuring a combination of illustrations and text that informs and educates the reader.

### LIFESTYLE ILLUSTRATED

Living and lifestyle activities e.g. cooking, DIY, gardening, with particular attention being given to consistently high standards of design and production.

### LITERATURE

Fiction, poetry, biography and letters – both hardback and paperback.

### EDUCATIONAL BOOKS

This applies to educational books produced for schools, colleges and universities. The ability to capture and retain the readers' attention is important in this category.

### SCHOLARLY, ACADEMIC & REFERENCE BOOKS

For example atlases, research studies, should include clean designs, exceptional finishing and can be complimented with photography.

### CHILDREN'S TRADE

All children's literature entered in age categories 0-8 and 9-16. One winner will be chosen from each age category.

### BEST JACKET / COVER DESIGN

Full colour or monochrome book jackets. Attention should be given to the visual impact, creativity and design.

### EXCELLENCE IN PRINT PRODUCTION

This award celebrates books that demonstrate impeccable print production – with a focus on innovation, quality, pre-press, sustainability and supply chain practices.

To be eligible for this award:

- All aspects of the book production (including pre-press, printing, binding and finishing) must be completed within the UK
- You must submit evidence of a book that supports your application and addresses the questions below
- The book must have been produced between August 2024 and November 2025

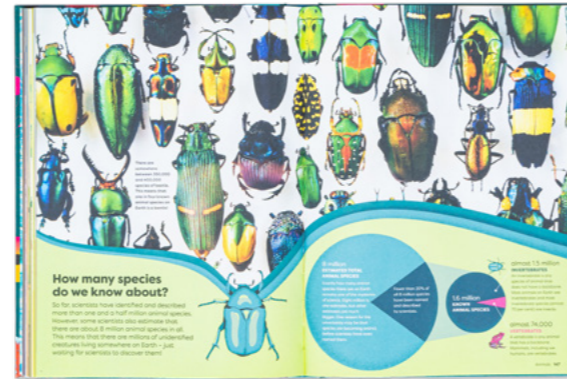
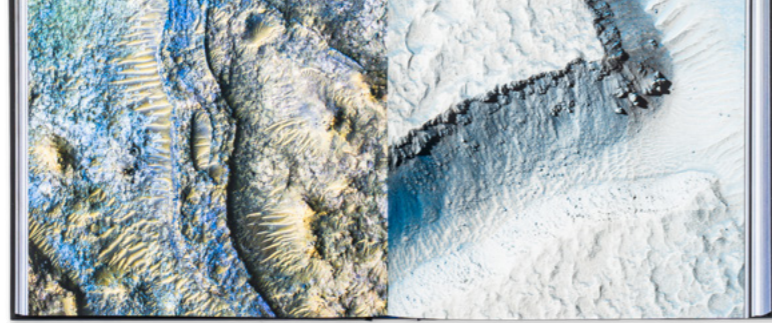
Please submit a written response (maximum 1000 words) addressing the following questions:
